Bedford-born rising star Tom Grennan will give his first live public performance post lockdown, and will be joined by the top 10 singer-songwriter, Mimi Webb and the 'Queen of South London', rapper Shaybo

About Tom Grennan

Born in Bedford but based in London, singer-songwriter Tom Grennan first found fame as the guest vocalist on Chase & Status's track "All Goes Wrong". A Hottest Record on Annie Mac's Radio 1 Show, the track gave Grennan the chance to cut his teeth in the Radio 1 Live Lounge and on BBC Two's Later... with Jools Holland.

But it might not have turned out that way. As a teenager, he had a promising football career, playing for Luton Town, Northampton Town, Aston Villa and Stevenage. "I was close to playing over in the States but something was telling me not to and obviously it was the music," he told Music Week earlier this year. "My head was turned by music and people saying I had a voice! Tom's first album Lighting Matches was one of the 10 best-selling debuts of 2018. Tom's highly anticipated second album 'Evering Road' debuted at #1 in the UK album chart. The album is Grennan's boldest artistic statement to date, described as "one of the country's bright young musical talents" by British GQ, and simply "epic" by the NME, The Sun praised Tom as "the ultimate Gen Z rock star". Evering Road' includes 'Little Bit Of Love', a UK Top Ten single that's now been streamed over 30 million times. 'Evering Road' is the follow up to 'Lighting Matches' - Tom's breakthrough album that cemented him as one of the UK's most vital and exciting new artists, and one of the Top Ten best-selling debuts of 2018. A Top Five UK Gold-certified record, 'Lighting Matches' has amassed over a quarter of a billion streams and seen Tom perform sold-out headline shows at The Royal Albert Hall and O2 Academy Brixton. New single, By Your Side, with Calvin Harris, is out now. Tom will perform across sold out UK tour dates from September 2021, including a landmark show at London's Alexandra Palace.

Mimi Webb projects a voice as magnetic, massive, and magical as her personality. Born and raised in south east London, Shaybo the hard-hitting truth-telling female rapper is not here to play games.
