

Records broken as Catherine Tate is fastest-ever DVD seller

March 19, 2007, London: Catherine Tate's Comic Relief Special DVD has beaten the likes of Star Wars, Pirates of the Caribbean and Harry Potter to become the fastest selling pre-order DVD of all-time on Amazon.co.uk.

The DVD, which became available for pre-order on Red Nose Day, immediately hit number one and racked up huge sales over the weekend, generating masses of money for Comic Relief in the process.

'We saw a surge of demand for the DVD on Friday night whilst the sketches were being shown on 'The Big One' on BBC 1 and since then people in their thousands have been visiting the site to make sure they get their hands on a copy', said Rakhi Parekh, Amazon.co.uk's Head of Media Demand.
