Undergoing a series of profile-boosting exercises with hilarious results, the housemate's fend off scandal and ridicule whilst nursing their political ambitions.

Also featured in the cast are Cynthia Nixon (*Sex and the City*), Wanda Sykes (*Curb Your Enthusiasm*), Amy Sedaris (*Strangers with Candy*) and Julie White (*Go On*), with cameos from Hollywood stalwart Bill Murray (as Senator Vernon Smits) and politicians such as Chuck Schumer and Anthony Weiner, who play themselves.

Alpha House was written and produced by *Doonesbury* creator [Garry Trudeau](#) alongside fellow producers Elliot Webb and Jonathan Alter.
