Christmas ordering deadlines extended – customers can now order by 23:59 on Saturday 20th December for Free Super Saver Delivery and customers in selected areas can order as late as 9am on Christmas Eve and receive gifts the same day

Luxembourg, 18th December 2014 – Amazon.co.uk expects its biggest surge in last minute Christmas shopping ever with sales between 20th and 24th December having increased by more than 300% over the last five years.

In response to customer demand, Amazon.co.uk is today extending its Christmas delivery deadlines, enabling customers to order presents by 23:59 on Saturday 20th December for Free Super Saver Delivery. Prime members within the M25 can order as late as 23:59 on Tuesday 23rd December at no extra cost for delivery on Christmas Eve. For last minute orders, customers can order as late as 9am on Christmas Eve and have items delivered that evening.

Amazon.co.uk now has more Christmas delivery options than ever before, including the option for customers to collect their parcels at <u>10.500 Post</u> <u>Offices</u> across the UK. As part of <u>Amazon Pickup</u>, shoppers can also collect parcels from <u>Pass My Parcel</u> stores, <u>Collect+</u> stores and <u>Amazon</u> <u>Lockers</u>.

- 20th December: Free Super Saver Delivery (order as late as 23:59)
- 21st December: Standard Delivery (order as late as 18:00)
- 23rd December: <u>One-Day Delivery</u> (order as late as 23:59 within the M25) or <u>Express Delivery</u> for 1pm the Next Day (order as late as 7pm)
- 24th December: <u>Same-Day Delivery</u> (order as late as 9am in <u>selected areas</u>)
